INTRODUCTION

The College of Education offers a Master's Program in **Education**, "The Unified Degree". The objective of the program is to develop the student's abilities of research, knowledge and skills. The program also promotes integration between the knowledge branches "Theoretical and practical", which should be in harmony with the applicational nature of the program. The study plan includes the completion of (39) credits for thesis option and (36) for non-thesis option. The degree is divided into two tracks: Thesis track (30) + thesis(9) and Non-thesis track (36) credits+ Comprehensive Examination Project (non-credit).

According to the University Council decision dated 4/2/2007, Thesis students admitted with effect from September 2007 are exempted from the comprehensive examination.
