INTRODUCTION

The College of Education presents a Master's program in the **Foundation of Education**. The program aims to establish a long-term educational philosophy for preparing students to conduct scientific research and implanting the moral and intellectual values of education in the development of intellectual and social life of education in addition to preparation of educational researcher and critical thinker capable of developing science and scientific knowledge in the field of education in accordance with contemporary educational philosophies. The study plan consists of 39 credits for both thesis and non-thesis options.
